
Azed No. 2,624 'Right and Left'



Apart from 1 Across, which is normal, each clue is really two clues, side by side but not overlapping, the answers to which are to be entered in the two similarly numbered spaces in the diagram, either side of the central vertical bar-line. Either entry may be clued first, and the division is not necessarily marked by punctuation. Solvers must determine which goes where.
